The situation of violence in Honduras does not allow many single mothers to work. There is much discouragement in our town, however we continue doing what God calls us to do. We have begun to feed a group of six Seniors, who are given a monthly provision, which includes basic food. Rice, beans, corn, cooking oil etc. This effort began with an old man who has no legs and begs in our city in a wheelchair. That day I found him on the street begging and the temperature was 42 degrees Celsius. You can imagine this desperate senior, asking under that terrible temperature. So I went to buy

food for a week and sent it to his home. Many times we complain about our situation but there are people who are worse off than us.

CHURCH PLANTING: We continue working in La Lima and in Lejamaní. Comayagua with evangelization. Pastor, Roberto in La Lima, he recently baptized 14 new believers And the Church in Leiamaní, baptized seven new people. Congregations continue to sow the Light of the gospel. Thank you for your support and prayer.

WOMEN MINISTRY: Marina continues to support the sewing school in Lejamaní. At this moment there are only 6 students. We also continue working with the





CHILDREN: Last Saturday, a series of 8 lessons about Bible stories was finished in which children in the soup kitchen are instructed in the Bible. We have about 160 children that we support with lunch, before going to school, Please pray for these families. Many of these single mothers have no work. It was reported to me that one of the volunteers who serves in the Bible school, went to pick up some children, it was about nine o'clock in the morning and the children



her that she let them sleep the whole morning and I woke them up before sending them to the Feeding center, for lunch, that way they did not ask for breakfast—hoping would hold them through the afternoon. God have mercy on our people. And to you once again—*Thank* you supporting us ... EP

FOCUS ON CUBA BRIAN JAMES & DR. LEWIS: SEPTEMBER 26 – OCTOBER 10

The first week Brian and Terry will travel 728 kilometers east by car to Holguin to meet with the orphaned children from the plane crash this spring that killed their parents who were pastors. Each of their birthdays happen to be in September so we will arrange a birthday party for them with a pinata and cake along with some gifts. They love the ocean and we want to bring them some snorkles and masks. Some of their care-givers have some personal needs and we will bring that to them.

We will also be working that week with Teen Challenge in Holguin where two of the students are graduating. We will do a tour of some of the mission

churches in the area to encourage them and minister to them. Amilkar will be with us from Havana and he has an amazing testimony of how God saved him. He was a high-ranking warlock and God turned him into an evangelist. This is all in the first week. We will then drive back to Havana to pick up the Men's Mission Team arriving on October 3.

The second week will be focusing on ministry in two Provinces. We will do leadership training, evangelism, micro-financing, feed-a-village, minister in various churches, and just allow us to be blessed by God and our Cuban brothers and sisters as we fellowship together. You can still join this Men's Mission Team if you contact Dr. Lewis before he leaves. You need to contact him prior to September 25th by email or by phone to arrange your participation in this adventure with God and missions. *Still need another \$ 5000 before we leave in a couple of weeks...pray.*



Do you have any used phones that are NOT older that 3 years old. Reason: The Cuban government has changed the phone system so that those with phones older than 3 years will no longer work. That means the majority of Cubans will have lost their way to communicate both in and outside of Cuba. You could mail us your old phone and it will go to Cuba.



FOCUS ON ETHIOPIA BERHANU GOES BACK TO ETHIOPIA: SEPTEMBER 18 – OCTOBER 30.

God is doing an amazing things in Ethiopia. We are seeing literally thousands of Muslims being converted to Christianity. On one of the last trips we provided 30,000 discipleship manuals designed specifically for these new Christians and trained church leadership in having a united approach to disciple these Muslim converts. Now we need thousands of Bibles in their language that we can purchase in Ethiopia. We are facilitating the baptism of thousands of Muslim converts by providing transportation to a secure area and providing four days of lodging and training before their baptism. We are helping the poorest of families with their "Back to School" needs for their children. We have also

built some very humble places of worship in four different communities for these new converts. We are providing training and help to pastors and providing some resources for an orphanage. We are praising God for a newly elected Christian Prime Minister who is bringing peace to our country. Thank God for this man He has put in place. Christians are having more freedom than they have for many years. Persecution of Christians still exists and there are horrifying examples of this. Christ is the light of the world and He is starting to shine brighter every day as revival is coming to Ethiopia. *The budget for this mission trip is \$ 51,000 and and \$32,000 has been raised.
