INDUCTION SERVICE FOR BERHANU AYANO

Dr. Lewis was honoured to officiate at Berhanu's induction service. Berhanu Ayano becomes the Associate Director for Christians Empowering Organizations Ministries Inc.. Dr. Lewis remains as the Executive Director of the Ministries and Berhanu will take his place at such a time as God ordains.

In his message to Berhanu, Dr. Lewis shared the concept of Leadership Transition through the Bible and history. Beginning with Moses asking God to "appoint a man over the community to go out before them" (Numbers 27: 15-17) Moses initiated the succession plan, seeking guidance from God and making his decision crystal-clear to the people. Then Moses, publicly blessed Joshua.

Moving on to 2 Kings, the historical account of Elijah and Elisha set the scene for Elijah asking Elisha what he could do for him. Elisha had his answer ready, "Please let a double portion of your

spirit be upon me." If you compare the miracles of these great man,

you will see that "the mantle" that fell on Elisha symbolized that the request was honoured. Remember, "Elijah was a man with a nature like ours". James 5:14

In the New Testament we see the transition of leadership from the apostle Paul to young Timothy and of Christ to the Disciples. Jesus said, "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do, he will do also; and greater works than these he will do; because I go to the Father" John 14:12. In somewhat of a similar way as Elisha watching the amazing event of Elijah taken up into heaven so also did the disciples watch Jesus taken up into heaven. Jesus promised that His "mantle" (the Holy Spirit) would fall on them. Acts 1:6-11. God always

wants to do more in each successive generation.





Dr. Lewis then blessed Berhanu, praying that the power of the Holy Spirit would enable him to do far more than what has been done. Prayed for protection of his marriage and family. Prayed for the support of God's people. Prayed that God would help him guard his heart, make his vision clear, and guide him each step of his journey.

No man will be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I have been with Moses, I will be with you; I will not fail you or forsake. Joshua 1:5. You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in my name He may give to you. John 15:16 For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; and that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may

be filled up to all the fullness of God. Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, ²¹ to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen. Ephesians 3:14-21







Last week in Togo, Africa: Lewis Swann

The Sight.org team traveled 53 miles to the village of Moretan to find 206 people, many blind, who came in hopes of receiving the sight-restoring cataract surgery. This village has very likely never seen an eye doctor, so the people here have been suffering from preventable blindness for many years.

A few days later, 50 people got their sight back! Some of them can see for the first time in years. That means

grandparents can see their grandchildren for the first time, mobility is no longer a burden, and walking canes (not candy canes) were thrown away! We will continue to work in this new village until all patients are seen. Our surgeries have a tremendous success rate with extraordinarily few complications. We attribute this to our excellent doctor, Dr. Djigbondi K. Nestor Avia, and prayers of our team and supporters. You can give sight for \$150. LS



- Our main purpose for CEOM was to visit the 2 schools that we have supported.
- With great delight we arrived at the Renanim School to a CELEBRATION! Once a

month the individual student that birthday's fall in the month are celebrated!! There was music, dancing, a large screen at the front, cake and JOY! The name of the individual child was called and their face appeared on the large screen. The other children cheered gave hi-fives and hugs as the child went up on stage and received a card and a small gift



- The teachers once again explained the needs of these students with special needs, mental development disorders, physical disabilities of all levels and the various challenges faced in educating 120 children. This is a very serious dedicated team that have devoted their time to not only training in life skills but installing worth and self-esteem. We were very thankful to once again to support the travel expenditures for the hydrotherapy program. This school has just won an Excellence Award for the best school for Special needs students
- We also visited a young lady from the Danciger high, a Russian Immigrant that needed some assistance. We met this lovely young lady
 2 years before as she was taking part in a Holocaust study & trip to Poland. She is doing extremely well at her studies, while working in
 a Chocolate store. We were treated to some delicious products.
- We have supported through Danciger High and at the recommendation of Dubi Shlenger, teacher at the school and excellent chef, several appliances and funds to purchase food for a cooking class for the students. They get together three times per week for training for their futures and to Mr. Shlengers' surprise some of these student's families do not have adequate funds for proper meals. This class not only feeds their minds, but hungry bodies. They have made lunches for the teachers which has helped to bond the students and teachers.
- We were blessed to spend some time touring with a remarkable lady, Brenda who is a liaison between the Medical professionals and
 poverty-stricken families of various decent, to ensure these children are cared for. We went into Samaria and up to some very
 interesting places. This lady knows the history and landmarks of Israel.



• On a personal side, we were invited to a wedding, an incredible wedding out in the desert. Such joy as the scripture was read and the families danced together after the vows were said. It was a privilege to be included in this event.

would be several other young girls and boys prostituting themselves to help feed their families. From the depth of my heart I thank you for helping us make this possible. Thousands of Haitian children are not allowed to go to school in the Dominican and we praise God for the opportunity to help a few. Thank you.
